1. It is submitted by Mr. Jagjit Singh, Id. Sr. Standing Counsel for the Indian Railways that given the grievance brought to the notice of the respondents regarding failure to notify reservation for blind candidates in Circular No.2/2018, the respondents have examined the matter and proposed to bring out a corrigendum on this aspect, which is expected to be brought out by tomorrow i.e. 28th February, 2018.

2. Mr. Jagjit Singh further submits, as instructed by Mr. A. Wasan, Joint Director (Establishment), Railway Board that in all

3. He may also take instructions as to whether Mr. S.K. Rungta, Id. Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioner or any other person conversant with law relating to disability can interact with the competent authority in the Railways so that no difficulty with regard to this category arises in the recruitment process undertaken by the Railways for any post.
