**ORDER**

1. On behalf of the writ petitioner, it is submitted by Mr. S.K. Rungta, learned Senior Counsel that the corrigendum brought out by the respondents notifies a few vacancies reserved for visually impaired persons. However, a grievance is made that the reservation is hopelessly insufficient and does not comport to the statutory requirements. This aspect may be dealt with in the counter affidavit which to be filed by the respondents.
2. It is made clear that anything done by the respondents during the pendency of the writ petition shall abide by the outcome of the

writ petition.

3. It is further submitted by Mr. Rungta, learned Senior Counsel that the respondents have required that the blind applicants shall give full details of scribe, who shall assist them while taking the examination, without indicating the schedule of the selection process i.e. the date of the examination. In view of the above, it is not possible to indicate the availability of the scribe on the date which may be fixed ultimately.

4. In view of the above, the respondents shall for the time being accept the applications of the visually impaired persons without insisting for the details of the scribe, who is to assist them. These persons shall be given an opportunity by the respondents to give particulars of the scribe after the selection process and the date of the examination is notified by the respondents.

5. Urgent steps in this regard shall be taken by the respondents within 10 days from today.
